

# **Growing Curb Appeal at Bellevue Botanical Garden**

On June 25, 2022, the Bellevue Botanical Garden (BBG) will celebrate its 3<sup>th</sup> anniversary. For the past four years, the Master Gardener Foundation of King County and the WSU Extension Master Gardener Program in King County have been among ten partner groups that support various areas of BBG. This support is most visible through the Ask-a-Master-Gardener clinic in the public garden. Our work has earned Master Gardeners a place at the table of influencers and BBG leaders.

Master Gardeners of King County were asked to participate in the development and planting of four new supersized containers to be sited at the entrance breezeway of the Garden. These new containers – over 40 inches high and wide – will be a significant improvement over the older, smaller containers. The containers and all plant materials were made possible by a generous BBG donor.

Two of our veteran Master Gardeners with extensive skills in large container design worked together to plan these containers. Master Gardener Karen Tollefson and Clinic Leadership Team (CLT) member Molly van der Burch conceptualized the containers' design. They gathered several unique, structural plants and many smaller shrubs and dwarf plants. Dozens of colorful annuals and some graceful "spillers" completed each large container.

Planting was supported by two members of the BBG Clinic: Master Gardener Theresa Meyer-Gabel and CLT member Brenda Spilker. On a damp and chilly day in early May, 85 bags of soil and compost were hefted into the containers and a bold statement was planted at the Garden's entry. A sign acknowledging

the Program's role in creating these beautiful containers will complete the display.

Be sure to join the Master Gardener team at the June 25 celebration and thank the crew who helped make this project happen.


