**Annual seed**

**Limnanthes douglasii (Meadow foam)**  
**Nemophila menziesii (Baby Blue Eyes)**  
**Collinsia parviflora - a great native annual for shade**

**Example : A No Water bed in my Garden**

**Arctostaphylos 'Dr. Hurd'**  
**Grevillea 'Canberra Gem'**  
**Phlomis 'Sunningdale Gold'**  
**Tulipa linifolia**

**A hard to water spot**

**Kniphofia caulescens (Spearlily)**  
**Erigeron speciosus (Fleabane) - a long blooming native perennial**  
**Polemonium carneum (Showy jacob's ladder)**  
**Sedum spathulifolium**

**A Ghastly Ditch**

**Collomia grandiflora (Wild Phlox) – Another annual**  
**Echinops ritro (Globe Thistle)**  
**Cistus 'Little Gem' (Dwarf rock rose)**  
**Grevillea victoriae 'Murray Valley Queen'**

**Low water in shade to part shade...**

**Azara microphylla**  
**Camassia cusickii and C. quamash**  
**Omphalodes cappadocica (Turkish Navelwort) also 'Starry Eyes'**  
**Azara dentata**

**Dryopteris affinis 'Cristata'**

**Pacific Coast Hybrid Iris - Divide in late fall through early winter to create more**

**A few standout plants for low water garden**

**Leptospermum grandiflorum (Mountain tea tree)**

**Leptospermum namadgiensis**

**Osmanthus x fortunei (Sweet olive)- A hybrid between O. fragrans and O. heterophyllus**

**Acer circinatum 'Burgundy Jewel' – A purple leaved vine maple selection**

**Native Plants for Shade...**

**Sedum spathulifolium seems to grow well in the bright shade**

**Disporum smithii (Prosartes smithii) known as Smith's Fairy bell**

**Vancouveria chrysantha (Siskiyou inside-out flower), V. hexandra and V. planipetala**

**Asarum caudatum (Wild Ginger)**

**Mahonia nervosa - Low Oregon Grape**

**Oxalis oregana - Redwood Sorrel**

**Polystichum munitum - Sword Fern**

**Other Plants For Partial shade**

**Iris confusa can take dry shade**

**Cyclamen coum and C. hederifolium**

**Low Water Plants for Sun**

**Mediterranean Bulbs: Crocus tommasinianus 'Roseus', C. chrysanthus 'Deep Water'**

**Tulipa praestans 'Shogun' – A great species Tulip**

**West Coast Bulbs: Allium cernuum (Nodding Onion) and Allium amplexans (Tapertip onion)**

**Best plants of the last year**

**Phlomis 'Sunningdale Gold' - Many of the Jerusalem sage varieties are worth growing for a low water garden.**

**Mahonia repens – creeping oregon grape**

**Erigeron glaucus 'Wayne Rodrick' - Sea side daisy.**

**Symphotrichum subspicatum - Douglas Aster.**
