Report Spotted Lanternfly

Have you seen this pest?



Spotted lanternfly poses a serious threat to Washington hops, grapes, stonefruits, hardwood trees, farms, parks, and gardens.

Adults: July - Oct

1 inch long with spotted wings



Eggs: Sep - June

Eggs have mud-like covering



Nymphs: April - July

Black or red with white spots
